Dr. George Barber and Coach Roy Mulholland, Associate Director, are in their 20th seasons as head men's & women's basketball coaches at Greenville University. Before arriving as head coach at Greenville, Barber served for 3 years as an assistant coach at Division I, Bradley University. Prior to that, he was on Rick Pitino's staff at the University of Kentucky where in 1996 the team won a Division I National Championship. Coach Barber is a veteran of the basketball camping scene and has coordinated hundreds of staff and thousands of campers as a coach. He has been a coach on staff at the prestigious 5-star basketball camp where camp teaching legend Howard Garfinkle quipped about Barber's defensive station, "Great station, not good, not good, but Great!" He has also worked with Hoop Heaven camps out of New York City, and with the 1998 USA Olympic Development team. Hoop Heaven ministers to NY City kids through means of basketball. He has coached a National Christian College Athletic Association All-Star team in the Czech Republic. Europe, as well as having coached in Beijing, China and, with Coach Mulholland, taken his own teams from Greenville to Europe, Central and South America where they went 24-3 in international competition. Coach Barber and Coach Mulholland's teams both won the SLIAC Championships last season. (MBB - SLIAC and 2017 WBB-NCCAA)

Greenville players are voted regularly to all-conference teams NCAA III, and as a member of the National Association of Christian Colleges, All-American squads, and has been awarded the SLIAC sportsmanship trophy six seasons in a row. The women's teams of GU placed 1st this past season in academic all conference players. These same players will be coaches and dorm staff at the camp. The WBB team won the NCCAA National Championship and the MBB team has won their confrence, while leading the national scoring at 126 ppg for the 3rd year in a row.
